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- **MISO's Seasonal Construct Impact**
 - Adjustments in planning and outage scheduling to optimize capacity accreditation credits
 - Challenges in predicting performance during critical hours
 - Impact of unit downtimes on accreditation
- **Balancing Reliability and Sustainability**
 - Priority on reliability and affordability in resource planning
 - Increasing customer demand for green energy and 24/7 renewable resource matching
 - Challenges in backfilling intermittent renewable resources with dispatchable energy
- **Integrated Resource Planning (IRP)**
 - IRP is a planning tool, not a commitment to specific resources
 - Current IRP initiated in 2022, complications arising from new MISO seasonal construct
 - IRP's role in anticipating customer needs and resource availability meeting capacity and energy needs
